ELIGIBILITY:

The person should be residents of Garfield County and an outstanding citizen/group that gives back to our community. They must be actively involved in work toward the betterment of our community and have dedicated many hours of service and be an upstanding member of society.

PROCEDURE:

- A. Nominations are due in the chamber office by June 29th.
- B. Nominations shall consist of the Official Nomination Form, including the following questions: - Describe the nominee’s notable activities and accomplishments – personal, professional, volunteer or otherwise - Describe how the nominee is/has been instrumental in initiating or leading efforts to benefit our community - What involvement in organizations or leadership roles has the nominee held in their community? - Why should this nominee serve as Grand Marshal?
- C. The person selected to be the Grand Marshal will be notified by the chamber to ensure attendance at the fair parade to be held the Saturday morning of the Fair.

JUDGING:

Judging will be done by the Chamber Board of Directors. We reserve the right to determine additional persons for consideration.
